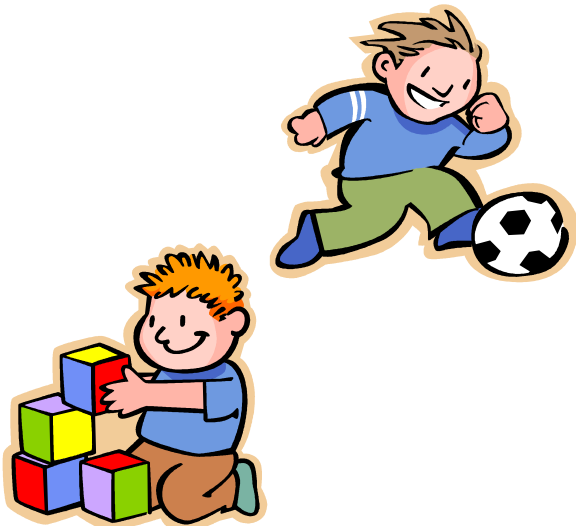
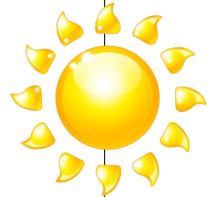
Child Find infant and preschool screenings can answer many questions about your child’s development. It is a program of NW Colorado BOCES in partnership with Horizons intended to identify children who might need extra support.

If you have concerns about a child between the ages of birth to 3 years, call Horizons in Grand and Jackson Counties at **887-1141**, or in Routt County at **871-8558**.

For children between the ages of 3 and 5 years, call the NW BOCES preschool in Granby at **887-3312**, in Fraser at **726-8033**, in Kremmling at **724-9483**, in North Park at **723-3300**, in Steamboat at **879-5888**, in Hayden at **276-3756**, or in South Routt at **638-1065**.

CHILD FIND

The Child Find Team at NW BOCES can provide a free screening and/or evaluation for all children birth to 5 years of age suspected of having a developmental delay or disability.

Includes:

- Child Find Coordinator
- Part C Coordinator (for children birth to three years of age)
- Speech/Language Therapist
- Early Childhood Special Educator
- Occupational Therapist
- Physical Therapist
- School Psychologist
- Audiologist

Services

Screening: developmental screening in all areas; speech/language, fine motor skills, gross motor coordination, learning, hearing/vision, and social adaptability

Assessment: comprehensive evaluations for children who may be in need of early childhood services, including special education programs

Consultation: information provided to parents about child development, behavior management, and community resources

Community Referrals: information and referrals to community resources which provide a variety of services, including preschool programs

Who Can Refer a Child for a Child Find Screening?

- Doctors/Nurses
- Social Workers
- Child Care providers
- Anyone who works with children between birth and 5 years of age
