

- Audible Manager:

 - o Enter your user name and password.




Click on Software

You will be prompted to pick a device.




- Click on Install Audible Manager.

 - Note: You can always Add a New Device at a later time from the Device menu in the Audible Manager.






- Connecting a device:
 - o Open Audible Manager.
 - Connect the device with the USB port on the computer. Your Windows operating system will recognize and install the player automatically.
 - o Right click on the device in the left panel and pick Activate.




- Enter your Audible user name and password at the prompt.
- You will see your device in the right-hand panel.
- Ordering books:

 - o Enter your user name and password.




- o To order a new book, search for it by keyword, title, author, or narrator.
