

Funding Proposals, Grants and Special Projects

State and Federal Aid Eligibility Determination

The BOCES shall use state and federal funds to the fullest extent. Therefore the Board authorizes the executive director to apply for such funds from the appropriate state and federal agencies, provided that none of the conditions of acceptance are inconsistent with Board policy, the objectives of the BOCES or applicable state and federal law.

The BOCES is authorized by state law to use contributions from participating school districts to match state, federal and other special agency funds when required for the acceptance of such matching funds.

The executive director shall keep the Board informed of available sources of state, federal and other special funds outside regular BOCES sources for the support of schools and/or for the enhancement of programs in the BOCES.

To ensure coordination and avoid confusion in developing proposals and making application for specially funded projects, the executive director shall ultimately be responsible for the preparation of proposals and their review.

No grant application will be submitted without the review and approval of the executive director.

No grant may be accepted without approval of the executive director, Board and Superintendents' Advisory Council.
